


Homework Expectations
Learners will: *Complete homework to the best of their ability. * Ensure they have correct materials to complete homework i.e. worksheet, reading book etc. *Take responsibility to ask teacher to explain homework if still not sure what to do.
Parents will: * Provide opportunities for learners to complete their homework on time. * Support child to do their best work. * Provide help and support with homework where necessary. * Leave marking to the teacher as it helps us spot where there might be a problem but contact the school if there is any sign of anxiety. * Sign diary to confirm homework is completed.



<u><b>Teachers will:</b></u> * Set achievable tasks which can be completed in the given timescale.
* Issue homework on a Monday and collect in to mark on Friday of the same week.
* Correct homework regularly and make sure the standard is acceptable and provide constructive feedback where appropriate.
*Contact SMT if homework is not completed on a regular basis. They in turn will contact the parents.

The following lists are only suggestions and other activities may be included from time to time.
<ul> <li>Primary One and Two</li> <li>daily:</li> <li>* Reading for enjoyment.</li> <li>* Phonics activities.</li> <li>* Numeracy skills e.g.</li> <li>number bonds, flash cards,</li> <li>matching games.</li> <li>* Interdisciplinary when</li> <li>appropriate.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Primary Three weekly:</li> <li>* Reading for enjoyment.</li> <li>* Literacy task.</li> <li>* Numeracy skills e.g.</li> <li>tables.</li> <li>* Interdisciplinary when appropriate.</li> </ul>

Primary Four and Five weekly: * Reading for enjoyment/reading skills * Numeracy skills e.g. tables, reinforcement sheets. * Literacy skills e.g. VCC grammar. * Interdisciplinary grid.	
Primary 6 and 7 weekly * Reading for enjoyment/literacy skills/reading skills. * Numeracy skills e.g. tables, reinforcement sheets to promote spee and accuracy. * Interdisciplinary grid	-
